

Our FINAL Prospectus focus for DECEMBER 2022 is for <u>everyone</u> to read and understand "FLORIDA STATE LICENSE DECAL".

FLORIDA STATE LICENSE DECAL (2023 registration)

All home owners must maintain current state registration decal on their mobile home. A copy of the current registration must be furnished to Community Management by Home Owner on an annual basis.

Current state license decal(s) shall be conspicuously displayed on the mobile home at all times. Please place it in the lower left-hand corner of a window which faces the street.

We ask that you please bring your 2023 home Registration(s) to the Community office once you receive it so we can take a copy for your file. This is the paper copy you receive with your sticker (not just the sticker). DEADLINE TO SUBMIT YOUR

REGISTRATION IS JANUARY 1, 2023.

COMPLAINTS AND NOTICES

All complaints to Community Management must be made in writing and signed and dated and submitted to the Community office. The delivery of written notices required by Chapter 723, Florida Statutes, under the terms of any Lot Rental Agreement or these rules and regulations shall be by mailing or delivery of a true copy thereof to the Community Management office as required by Chapter 723, Florida Statutes. If you have any complaints, recommendations, etc., please discuss them with the Community Management. **Avoid passing rumors on to others**. Come to the office--we will be glad to do everything possible to correct problem situations. Community Management is not responsible for delivery of personal notes, messages, etc.

Reminder on timeline for home repairs due to Hurricane Ian:

By December 31, 2022, you must provide a timeframe in which you plan to complete the work to your property. If you are hiring a contractor for the work to your property, you must provide a copy of the contract along with a time frame of when the work will be completed to the Community Office.

Note: if you are using a contractor to repair your property, please make sure they are insured and licensed with the state of Florida. If you need a permit for the work, you must contact Charlotte County.

DEBRIS REMOVAL INSIDE THE COMMUNITY HAS BEEN COMPLETE. IT IS
YOUR RESPONSIBILTY TO REMOVE METAL & DEBRIS OFF OF YOUR
PROPERTY AND DISPOSE OF IT PROPERLY. COMMUNITY MANAGEMENT
WILL NOT BE COLLECTING OR DISPOSING OF YOUR METAL OR YOUR
DEBRIS. THIS IS THE HOMEOWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY! IF DEBRIS IS LEFT
ON YOUR PROPERTY, YOU WILL RECEIVE A REMEDY NOTICE. IF THE
NOTICE IS NOT TAKEN CARE OF, A CONTRACTOR WILL BE HIRED, AT THE
HOMEOWNERS EXPENSE, TO REMOVE THE DEBRIS.
