CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

These last handful of months each and every one of you have been very gracious as we have started and completed projects. I cannot thank you enough for the support and understanding each of you have given us as we have moved through these renovations. Thank you!

The concrete fence on Harborview Road has now been removed and the replacement fence is being installed. This fence will be set back about eight feet from its original location to allow for easement of the highway, landscaping, and a smooth transition to the new entrance later on this year. Contactors will be working on both sides of the new fence and may be in yours/your neighbor's backyards to complete the project.



Dumpsters have been delivered adjacent to the pier, and removal began on June 22nd. The demolition and rebuild process will take approximately 4-6 weeks from beginning to completion. Permits for the remodel of the current community clubhouse have been applied

for and we are awaiting issuance to begin the remodel.

Greetings Harbor View Residents,

It is bittersweet to be writing this message to each and every one of you in the community. This last month, Nate and I have been blessed with a promotion within Newby Management and this has been our last month here at Harbor View. We wanted to take a moment and thank all of you for everything you have done for us. We have truly appreciated the outpouring of acceptance and kindness from each of you over the last year. We are extremely grateful to have had this opportunity to get to know each of you personally, and we have been blessed to share this year with you. It has been an absolute pleasure to have been your community managers. Thank you! I know you will give Heather and Bobby the same kindness, compassion, and understanding that you gave us. They are going to be a fantastic addition to Harbor View!

Summer season is in full swing and now is the time to review your community rules and regulations. A few reminders of some rules we will need to be implementing over the coming weeks.

- ❖ Patios, Driveways, & Carports Only standard outdoor lawn or patio furniture will be permitted on patios, lawns, driveways, or carports. Patios, Driveways, and Carports are not to be used for storage of any items including: household furniture, appliances, and tools (including ladders & storage containers). The hanging of tarps, blankets, rugs, or airdrying of any clothing is not permitted in the driveway, carport, lawn or lanai.
- ❖ Pressure Washing & Painting The exterior surfaces of the mobile home including the eaves and trim shall be kept free of mildew or discoloration. Mobile homes must be washed at least annually. Peeling, fading, or damaged exterior surfaces must be restored to the condition of a well-maintained home in the Community (including the cleaning of the home gutters and downspouts, & the cleaning of the roof of the home).
- ❖ Flowerbeds Home sites are to be kept free of dead limbs and weeds and shall not be permitted to become overgrown.
