MANAGER'S CORNER

Greetings Harbor View Residents!

We made it through some COLD February Florida days and we are FINALLY on our way to Sunshine and continued warmth! This is why we are all here... right?? 😊

Bobby and I are so excited for the opening of the club house and looking forward to all of the great events that will be taking place throughout this year! A special thanks goes out to the Harbor View Social Club who make all of these great events happen. Without the support of the Social Club, there would be no fun events or yummy foods for Community members to enjoy each week. Please consider joining the Social Club and attending their monthly meetings. Every bit of Community support helps make things run smoother and also allows for more events when there is more help!

We are going to continue each month to focus on a particular part of the Harbor View Prospectus that everyone in the community should review and abide by.

**We have noticed more and more homes storing belongings in carports/driveways that are not allowed and feel we should re-visit the Community Rules regarding Patios/Driveways:

Our focus for March is for everyone to continue to work on your Patios, Driveways, & Carports. This is a major focus for multiple reasons, and without cooperation, we are going to be made to start issuing Remedy Notices to residents who do not comply. (*Community Rules & Regulations, Page 57*)

Patios, Driveways, & Carports - Only standard outdoor lawn or patio furniture will be permitted on patios, lawns, driveways, or carports. **Patios, Driveways, and Carports are not to be used for storage of any items including: household furniture, appliances, and tools (including ladders & storage containers).** The hanging of tarps, blankets, rugs, or airdrying of any clothing is not permitted in the driveway, carport, lawn or lanai.

Our other Community focus for March is for everyone to understand and abide by rules for Leaving and Returning to the Community (SNOWBIRDS)
(Community Rules & Regulations, Page 55)

When leaving the Community for a period in excess of one week, Resident shall notify Management in advance of the date of departure and leave with Community Management complete information regarding insurance; contact information for a person to reach in case of emergency or to obtain access to the home upon prior written consent of Home Owner; lawn care and address where they can be reached during their absence from the Community; and the approximate date of return. Before departure from the Community, Resident must turn off water and advise management if electricity is to remain connected. Community Management must be notified upon Resident's return to Community.

****Please note...** it is important when you are LEAVING for the season to contact the Community office and to be sure we have your Northern address on file. It is just as important when RETURNING to the community, to let the community office know upon your return into the Community.
